

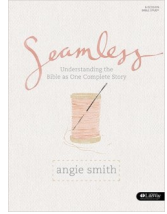
# Women's Fall 2017 Bible Studies

In this study, we will strive to **engage** you with scripture in order for you to recognize God's truth and promises throughout the entire Bible.

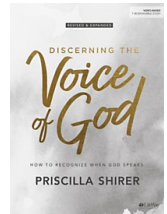


## Discerning the Voice of God - Priscilla Shirer

In this revised and expanded study, we will strive to **equip** you to discern God's voice and thus God's will for your daily life.

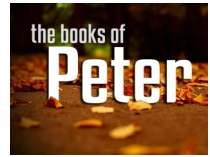


## 1 & 2 Peter
