### **Purpose**

### **Description of Duties**

- Oversee everything involved with MSM Sunday Mornings & HSM Sunday Nights.
- Oversee the MSM and HSM Calendar.
- Planning of Biblical teaching.
- Monitoring doctrine of all teaching and preaching.
- Budget planning for MSM and HSM.
- Oversee all small group leaders.
- Weekly communication and meeting with MSM and HSM teams
- Constantly recruiting and training adult leaders.
- Oversee background checks for volunteers and safety procedures for Student Ministry
- Create and lead a team of student leaders.
- Oversee transitions: 5<sup>th</sup> graders moving from Children's Ministry to MSM and 8<sup>th</sup> graders moving from MSM to HSM.
- Develop parental relationships including sending monthly parent updates.
- Collaborate with Family & Missions Minister to review events/programs as successes or failures and assess areas for improvement.
- Lead, organize, and execute all MSM and HSM trips.
- Function as a part of the FCC staff in areas such as (but not limited to): hospital calls, staff meetings, retreats, keeping of vision, and being a team player.
- Active part of Family Ministry team, even going outside of MSM/HSM to help lead, organize, and execute events/programs/trips.
- Counseling of middle school and high school students and their families.
- Implement follow up plan for new students.
