

## Frequently Asked Questions

Where does this trip take place?

- New Orleans, Louisiana

When does this trip take place?

- Sunday, October 8<sup>th</sup> (we will depart around 9 AM) – Saturday, October 14<sup>th</sup> (we will return around 6 PM)

Where do you stay?

- We stay at Camp Hope NOLA just outside the city in Arabi, LA.

How many students are in a room?

- Girls will stay in one large bunk room and boys will stay in a separate bunk room.

What/where do they eat?

- Homemade meals will be provided at Camp Hope during the trip and/or sack lunches for days the team is out on a worksite.

How much money should my student bring?

- Cash for 3-4 meals (suggested \$60+) and any money they would like to spend on snacks, or souvenirs.

What does a typical day look like?

- Breakfast, devos, leave for worksites, lunch, continue working at sites, return to Camp Hope, dinner and a speaker or outing.

How many Leaders will go to New Orleans?

- This depends on how many students we take. Our goal is 1 leader to every 6 students.
